

Language to Use to Remember Crown Hill in Your Will

One advantage of giving by Will is the flexibility it offers. Three of the most popular forms a bequest can take are:

A fixed amount of money:

“I give to the Crown Hill Heritage Foundation, located in Indianapolis, Indiana, \$_____.”

A percentage of the estate:

“I give to the Crown Hill Heritage Foundation, located in Indianapolis, Indiana _____% of my estate.”

A residual bequest:

“I give all the residue of my estate, including real and personal property, to the Crown Hill Heritage Foundation located in Indianapolis, Indiana.”

If you wish to have your bequest applied to a specific program, simply add “...for the benefit of (name a program or historic structure)” to the language suggested above.

Consult an attorney when preparing legal documents.
